OCTOBER INCIDENTS

- Numerous thefts from autos throughout the month and throughout the neighborhood, with a couple of neighbors having their vehicle targeted twice!
- Two home, daytime burglaries reported (as of this date)
 - Police do have two men with ties to our immediate area with criminal theft convictions who they feel could be involved in these
 - One of the men has already been questioned, but there was not enough evidence to detain him
- A robbery happened on the north end; it appears to be related to a dispute between the parties involved and not of a broader concern for the neighborhood

NEWSPAPER UPDATE

- Received significant feedback about this and relayed it all to Diane Kay at the *Dispatch*. She is working with their contract delivery service to get this improved
- As of Oct 19th, still getting feedback about lack of delivery or poor delivery and one mention of proper delivery, all of which has been relayed to Diane
- Very mixed bag of delivery activity week of Oct 22nd. Some improvements on some streets; some didn't get any paper at all.
- Will keep following through until we get some reasonable fix

SUICIDE PREVENTION SEMINAR

- Basic Statistics
 - 1 person dies by suicide in Franklin County every 2.2 days
 - 1 million *documented* attempts in U.S. every year
- **Our backyard** (suicides or attempts here in the neighborhood)
 - Attempts in past 3 years: at least 3 that I am aware of
 - Death by suicide in past 3 years: 2
- Sponsoring Suicide Prevention Seminar with guest Rick Baumann of the North Central Mental Health Services
 - Thursday, November 29, from 7 to 8:30 PM at Resurrection Evangelical Lutheran Church

- Presentation by Rick and video followed by question and answer session
- Focus will be on addressing myths and what is known about people considering suicide and why they do and what to look for...this hits families of all kinds
- Promotions of the seminar will be among our neighborhood, the church parish, the Hilliard City Schools (targeting in particular the counselors and health teachers at the middle and high school levels), the other coordinators Ofc Paulus works with, and the local paper for the community at large
- Proposal: I would like to include the Civic Association as a sponsor along with the block watch and the church
