Neighborhood Social

We are looking into the Cricket Club doing a demonstration as well as the Imagination Playground. Crisha Donelson works for McDonald Corp. and will be trying to get Ronald McDonald to make an appearance.

Mowing on Hilliard Rome

The triangle attached to the neighborhood belongs to Hilliard and they will take care of this as well as the strip of grass to Gillette. They are talking to Peabody Landscaping about doing this. The strip of grass that runs south along the neighborhood is the responsibility of each of the homeowners that back up to Hilliard Rome.

Front Entrance Beautification
