CROSS CREEK BLOCK WATCH REPORT FOR CROSS CREEK VILLAGE CIVIC ASSOCIATION MEETING, Dec 6 2012

NOVEMBER INCIDENTS

- Car blew past crossing guard on Springdale early in the month
- Domestic violence incident reported
- Several solicitor complaints: one was two men claiming to be collecting donations for Ronald McDonald House; Kirby salespeople; representatives of at least one gas distribution vendor (very pushy sales people)
- Theft from motor vehicle reported on Redlands
- Several car alarms sounded late one evening on Cashion; police called
- A row of roughly a dozen mailboxes on Silver Bow were found to be open one morning; found out from Ofc Paulus that a neighborhood off Feder Rd had a similar incident happen within a couple of days of the Silver Bow incident and mail had been stolen in that case
- Vehicle vandalism in the Stoneybrook condos (off Springdale)...tried to determine if it could be connected to the vehicle that was vandalized on Springdale at the end of October but could not verify a connection
- Asked by resident on Parker if there could be any connection to the arrest of burglars off Feder with the burglary of her property; again, could not make that determination, though Ofc Paulus was doubtful they were connected since the arrestees were working primarily apartments and there was no evidence they had come north of I-70; referred her to the burglary division for follow up on her case
- Suspicious vehicle report on Cutler
- Smashed mailbox report on Phoenix
- Graffiti sprayed on south tower of front entrance structure; as soon as I can locate my can of graffiti treatment, I'll go clean it off

NEWSPAPER UPDATE

- Still getting feedback of neighbors' being missed
- Have expressed great misgivings with contact at *The Dispatch* about the eventual resolution of this issue given how long it has taken so far and how many times there have been setbacks on progress
- Will seek input again this week
- Overall, the delivery onto the driveway has improved; still too many people not getting the paper, though

SUICIDE PREVENTION SEMINAR

- Attendees: 21 (over half were from Cross Creek Village!); 3 guests including the speaker, his wife, and a volunteer from the suicide prevention hotline
- Very good feedback from folks about the information in this seminar
